

- 13. Protecting Vulnerable groups in a Tech-Driven world

These sub-themes are only illustrative. Any relevant topics connected to the theme can be considered.

Call for Papers

The Centre for Law and Technology of the School of Law, The NorthCap University invites original, unpublished research papers and conceptual papers from academicians, legal practitioners, technologists, researchers, and students on themes and sub-themes related to the intersection of law, technology and society.

Selected papers will be given the opportunity for presentation during the conference, and following a peer-review process, the best submissions will be considered for publication in the NCU Law Review, a peer-reviewed biannual academic publication of the Centre of Post-Graduate Legal Studies (CPGLS) at the School of Law.

- Joint authorship is permitted for up to two authors per paper.
- Submissions must be original and not under consideration elsewhere.
- Authors are encouraged to explore interdisciplinary approaches, linking law with technology, society, ethics, governance, and innovation policy.

Submission Guidelines

- 1. All submissions are to be made in English.
- 2. Scholars, Researchers, Practitioners, Academicians and Students pursuing five-year LLB or three-year LLB or any under/post-graduate degree programme are eligible to send their abstracts on issues related to the above themes.
- 3. Authors of selected abstract will be given an opportunity to present their papers at the conference.
- 4. Joint authorship is permitted, subject to a maximum of two co-authors.
- 5. Authors are required to do the individual registration.
- 6. On approval through a peer-reviewing process, the best papers will be considered for publication in the NCU

Law Review.

- 7. A brief profile of the author indicating his/her designation, email ID, contact number and address has to be sent along with the abstract (250-300 words) of the paper to the Organizing Committee. The abstracts and full papers should be emailed to conferencelawtechnology@ncuindia.edu
- 8. Once the payment has been made, please take a screenshot of the transaction reflecting the transaction ID including the UPI Ref no. and email it along with the scanned copy of the registration form to conferencelawtechnology@ncuindia.edu
- 9. The Full-Length Paper should not exceed 6000 words excluding footnotes. It should be typed in Times New Roman Font Size 12 with 1.5" line spacing and 10 pt. for the footnotes on A4-size paper with 1" margin on all sides using MS Word. Use of the ILI style of referencing and footnoting is to be followed.
- 10. Only the outstation participants (residing outside of Delhi NCR) have the option of presenting their papers in the Online mode.

***** Participants presenting in the offline mode will be given priority for early publication of their papers. The Best Paper Award will be conferred upon the most outstanding presenter(s), provided the full paper is submitted prior to the conference, and shall be restricted to offline participants only. Decision of the organizing committee shall be final and binding.
