

Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) is an initiative by the Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India, aimed at bringing transformational change in rural development processes by leveraging knowledge institutions to help build an inclusive India.

Mission:

UBA's mission is to enable higher educational institutions to work with rural communities in identifying development challenges and evolving appropriate solutions for sustainable development.

Objectives:

- The key objectives of UBA include:
- Introducing a development agenda within academic discourse and processes.
- Inculcating methodologies of fieldwork and interdisciplinary approaches in academic processes.
- Positioning higher education institutions as regional knowledge providers towards regional problems.
- Improving developmental outcomes such as roads, water, electricity, etc., through better access to knowledge.
- Inculcating scientific thinking within society.

Implementation:

Under UBA, higher educational institutions adopt clusters of villages and work closely with the communities to address various development challenges. This collaboration involves conducting field studies, identifying technological gaps, and implementing solutions that promote sustainable development.

UNNAT BHARAT ABHIYAN Phases:

UBA NCU EVENTS 2023-2024

1. Village Visit to Gwal Pahari: Induction

DATE: 21 August 2023

MODE: OFFLINE

AIM:

To engage with the community of Gawal Pahadi Village, promoting awareness on hygiene, sanitation, literacy, and legal knowledge while fostering holistic rural development through active student participation under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) program.

EVENT:

The UBA NCU Chapter organized a community service visit to Gawal Pahadi Village on 21st August 2023. The event witnessed participation from over 200 students who contributed through various impactful activities, including:

- Performing a Nukkad Natak to highlight the importance of hygiene and sanitation.
- Cleaning village streets and public spaces to promote cleanliness and environmental awareness.
- Conducting Legal and Digital Literacy sessions to educate villagers about their rights and the digital world.
- Performing surveys to collect data on healthcare, education, and socio-economic conditions in the community.

The event also acted as an induction for new students, allowing them to actively participate and earn credits for their contributions.

IMPACT:

The initiative successfully raised awareness on critical issues like hygiene, sanitation, and literacy among the villagers. 2. Village Visit to Daultabad: Induction

DATE: 22 August 2023

MODE: OFFLINE

AIM:

To engage with the rural community of Daulatabad, Pataudi, by fostering awareness on sanitation, hygiene, literacy, and legal issues, while actively contributing to the community's overall development through practical and impactful initiatives.

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

As part of its ongoing rural development efforts, **UBA NCU** organized a community service visit to Daulatabad. The event saw the enthusiastic participation of over 100 students, who engaged in various activities to address key community challenges. These included cleaning communal spaces, conducting surveys to assess local issues, and teaching villagers about legal and digital literacy.

surveys were conducted to better understand the infrastructure, healthcare, and educational challenges faced by the village. A home survey was also carried out to assess the specific needs of families in the community. This visit offered new students a valuable opportunity to experience community service firsthand, enriching their understanding of societal issues.

3. Village Visit to Sarhol: Induction

DATE: 25 August 2023

MODE: OFFLINE

UBA NCU Community Engagement Initiative at Sarhol

AIM:

To enhance societal awareness and make a positive contribution to the community by engaging with the rural population of Sarhol, focusing on issues such as sanitation, hygiene, education, and legal literacy.

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

As part of a three-day village visit program, the UBA NCU Chapter organized an impactful community engagement initiative in Sarhol. This visit aimed at connecting with the local villagers and raise awareness on vital subjects, including sanitation, cleanliness, education, and legal rights.

During the visit, the students interacted with both the boys' and girls' schools in the village. The group was divided into teams, each responsible for achieving specific goals, including conducting a cleanliness drive, providing legal literacy sessions, and carrying out a village survey to assess the needs of the community.

The students and villagers engaged in meaningful dialogue, with a focus on addressing local challenges and promoting awareness in key areas.

IMPACT:

IIT Delhi Visit DATE: 14th January 2024 MODE: Offline

AIM: To explore the implications of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, emphasizing the necessity to eradicate exclusion at its roots, and to transform activism into tangible actions for inclusive societal development.

EVENT: The event included participation in a National Workshop on "Unnat Bharat: Nurturing Inclusive Development for Amrutkal at IIT Delhi. During the workshop, the significance of Unnat Bharat Abhiyan was explored, and discussions focused on creating an inclusive society through concrete actions. The insights shared by the speakers highlighted the importance of transforming activism into impactful community development.

IMPACT: The workshop successfully underscored the need for eradicating exclusion at the societal level, with participants gaining a deeper understanding of how the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan can contribute to more inclusive and equitable development. The knowledge shared encouraged attendees to play an active role in translating these ideas into real-world solutions.



5. Village Visit to Sadhrana DATE: 20th January 2024 MODE: Offline

AIM: To raise awareness about the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, conduct surveys, empower farmers with tools like the Kisan Sabha app, and guide students on their career aspirations.

EVENT: On January 20th, 2024, under the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA), the team visited the NCU-adopted village of Sadhrana. The team conducted Baseline Household Surveys and Village Survey forms, trained farmers on using the Kisan Sabha app, and interacted with schoolchildren to offer career guidance. Posters were displayed to promote awareness about the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, and community engagement helped spread the initiative's goals.

IMPACT: The visit successfully raised awareness of the Unnat Bharat Abhiyan, providing villagers with useful tools for economic empowerment, such as the Kisan Sabha app. The surveys collected will help address infrastructure, sanitation, healthcare, and other challenges. Career discussions offered students new perspectives on their futures. Overall, the visit contributed to building an empowered and informed community for Sadhrana's future development.



 Village Visit Sadhrana: Project Reconnaissance DATE: 3rd February 2024 MODE: Offline

AIM: To conduct a feasibility study for proposing a compost pit for the village, investigate issues such as termite infestations and drainage blockages, and engage with villagers to gather insights on other community challenges.

EVENT: During the visit to Sadhrana, the team focused on assessing the feasibility of implementing a compost pit to support waste management and enhance sustainable farming practices. The research included evaluating the current environmental conditions and the potential for introducing composting practices within the village. In addition, an investigation into the termite infestation levels was carried out, as termites were causing significant damage to local infrastructure and crops. The team also examined the blockage of village drains, which was partly caused by cow dung cakes being left in and around drainage systems. Finally, team members engaged with a broader group of villagers to uncover additional issues affecting the community and explore possible solutions.

IMPACT: The visit provided valuable insights into the potential for a compost pit in Sadhrana, addressing waste management challenges while promoting eco-friendly practices. The research on termite infestations highlighted the need for pest control initiatives to preserve local structures and crops. By identifying the drain blockages caused by cow dung cakes, the team recognized an important aspect of the village's sanitation issue, which will be addressed in future interventions. Engaging with villagers allowed the team to understand other persistent community challenges, setting the stage for future development initiatives focused on improving the village's overall quality of life and infrastructure.



Swasthya Sangram: The Quest for Global Wellness DATE: 18th April 2024 MODE: Online

AIM: To raise awareness about global wellness, explore topics related to health and hygiene, and engage participants in discussions around the importance of mental health days.

EVENT:

The "Swasthya Sangram: The Quest for Global Wellness" event, organized by Unnat Bharat Abhiyan NCU, aimed to educate and engage participants on global wellness. The event featured three insightful short films: one focused on World Health Day 2024, another on health and hygiene practices, and a third on the significance of taking a mental health day.
