CHIEF GUEST AT CONVOCATION 2023



Prof. (Dr.) T G SitharamChairman, All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE),

Prof. (Dr.) T G Sitharam took over as Chairman, All India Council of Technical Education (AICTE), Govt of India on December 21, 2022. He was the Director of Indian Institute of Technology Guwahati, Assam for 3.5 years (from July 2019 to December 2022). He obtained his B.E. (Civil Engineering) from University of Mysore; Master's from Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore in 1986 and Ph.D. from University of Waterloo, Ontario, Canada in 1991. He worked as a lecturer at University of Waterloo soon after his PhD and later moved to University of Texas at Austin, Austin, Texas, USA (1992-94). He also held the position of Director (additional charge) at Central Institute of Technology Kokrajhar, Assam for 1.5 years (May 2021-November 2022). Presently, he is the Chairman, Board of Governors at CIT, Kokrajhar and Chairman, Board of Management of North East Regional Institute of Science and Technology (NERIST), Nirjuli, Arunachala Pradesh.

He is a Senior Professor in Department of Civil Engineering, Indian Institute of Science (IISc), Bangalore and has served IISc for the last 30 years. He held KSIIDC Chair Professor in the area of Energy and Mechanical Sciences, Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore from 2015 to 2018. He was instrumental in starting a Centre for infrastructure, sustainable transport and urban planning and Master's programme in the centre at Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore. He has served as a visiting, or honorary professor at many universities in countries such as Japan, Canada, USA, Hongkong, Australia and Republic of China.

He has published 500 technical papers, 20 books with Google scholar H-index of 53 and I-10 index 149 with more than 8614 citations. He has guided 40 Ph.D. students; 35 Masters' Students, 25 Postdoctoral students and several thousand industry professionals and teachers through continuing education workshops. He has filed for 5 patents, executed more than 120 consulting projects and 2 start-up companies to his credit. He was listed in the world's top 2% of scientists for the most-cited research scientists in various disciplines by Stanford University in 2020. Again, his name appeared in the top 2% of scientists in Elsevier by Stanford University in 2021 and 2022. He was part of an 8-member expert panel set up to supervise Ram temple foundation-laying work for Sri Ram Janmabhoomi Teerth Kshetra at Ayodhya.

Prof. Sitharam has received Fellow of Indian National Academy of Engineering (INAE). He is the Fellow of ASCE, Fellow of ICE (UK), Diplomat of Geotechnical Engineering (D.GE) from Academy of Geo-Professionals, ASCE; Honorary Fellow of IGS, Fellow of ISET, Fellow of ISES and many other Societies. He is also a certified professional engineer and chartered engineer from Institution of Engineers. He has received Sir M. Visvesvaraya Senior Scientist State Award for the year 2020 on 23rd March 2023 in the presence of Bharat Ratna Prof. CNR Rao & other dignitaries at IISc, Bangalore.

Other Important Conferences, Events, Competitions & Fests

Our commitment to multidisciplinary research took centre stage at the two-day National Workshop on 'Creating a Multi-Disciplinary Research Environment in HEIs.' The event was funded by NAAC and AIU.

In the realm of management and leadership, our School of Management and Liberal Studies, in collaboration with Shri Vishwakarma Skill University, Haryana, conducted a Management Development Programme (MDP). Scholarships & Financial Aid Awarded

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATIONS ————





Arizona State University, USA: The long-term collaboration between The NorthCap University and Arizona State University is focused on innovation and expanding access to quality higher education in India. NCU has been selected by ASU as its first comprehensive university partner in India. Unlike conventional academic partnerships which are restricted to a school, department or program, this is a university-wide strategic collaboration between both institutions. NCU's alliance with Arizona State University represents a far-reaching collaboration focused on student success through innovation, access to global knowledge, and future pathways to higher studies.

Queensland University of Technology, Australia: The MoU with Queensland University of Technology was signed in July 2023. This MoU signifies a strong partnership aimed at fostering academic growth and innovation. The purpose of this agreement encompasses a range of exciting initiatives that are set to enhance the learning experience and global exposure of our students: Joint venture Projects, Academic and Scientific activities, Student and Faculty Exchange, Dual/Joint degrees, and Resource Exchange.



Santa Clara University, California, USA: This MoU was signed in June 2023 to offer graduate program at SCU to undergraduate students of NCU with an application fee waiver, two annual scholarships worth US\$9000 for engineering applicants and two annual scholarships of US\$12000 for business studies applicants.



The University of North Florida, USA: The NCU has a collaboration with UNF, Florida, USA and the MoU was signed in March 2023. The agreement was signed for the Exchange of Faculty and Administrative/Professional staff, the exchange of students, Immersion Programmes, Research Collaborations and Joint Degrees.



University of Regina, Canada: The MoU with University of Regina, Canada was signed in June 2016 and renewed in 2023. Both sides make a sincere effort to promote collaborative research and educational endeavors, including the sharing of academic resources and publications, the exchange of professors for research, presentations, and discussions, and the exchange of students for study and research. For NCU BTech ECE and CSE students, the articulation process for the 3+1+MEng/MASc programme with U of R is now underway. After finishing their three years of BTech at NCU, the chosen candidates will be able to transfer to the University of Regina in Canada.



Shibaura Institute of Technology, Japan: A Partnership Agreement with Shibaura Institute of Technology, Japan was signed in August 2018 and renewed in June 2023, to undertake collaborative research and joint academic meetings, exchange of professors, researchers and students. Admission and Tuition fees are waived for NCU students on semester exchange.



Salem State University, USA: The NCU has a collaboration with Salem State University, USA. The agreement was signed in March 2023 for educational exchange programs which include Short and long-term exchange of faculty members and non-academic staff and student exchange. It also focuses on Collaborative research, summer internship/immersion, and Dual/ Joint degrees.



University of Chester, UK: A Partnership Agreement with the University of Chester, UK, was signed in 2012. The Chester Business School has over 1500 students with campuses at Chester and Warrington and has a good reputation at undergraduate and postgraduate-level courses.



University of Dayton, Ohio, USA: The University has signed a partnership agreement to undertake joint collaborative research and for student and faculty exchange programmes. The agreement was signed in May 2017.



Vilnius Tech University, Lithuania: The NCU has a collaboration with Vilnius Tech University, Lithuania and the MoU was signed in June 2023. The agreement is signed for the Exchange of Faculty and Administrative/Professional staff, the exchange of students, Immersion Programmes, Research Collaborations and Participation in conferences (including online), symposiums, short courses and scientific workshops.



Binus University, Indonesia: The NCU has established a collaboration with Binus University, located in Indonesia. The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the two institutions was signed in September 2023. The agreement aims to facilitate the exchange of information and experience related to educational exchange programmes, student exchange, immersion programmes, research collaborations, and joint degrees, including joint online programmes.















Providence University, Taiwan: A Partnership Agreement with Providence University, Taiwan was signed in October 2018, to undertake special short-term academic programs, joint collaborative research and for student and faculty exchange programmes.

Universiti Teknologi, Malaysia: A Partnership Agreement with Universiti Teknologi, Malaysia was signed in August 2020, for summer school, short courses and training, joint research and supervision, researcher/faculty/student attachment and exchange programmes.



Students benefit in terms of semester abroad at zero fee, immersion programmes at universities across 16+ universities with scholarships, joint research projects and funding and opportunity to participate in international competitions.

More than 400 students and faculty have obtained oracle certifications on Java Fundamentals and Database foundation so far. Department of CSE in collaboration with INOAUG (India Oracle APEX User Group) as academic partner of Oracle academy organized APEX UTSAV 2023 on 2nd September 2023 where more than 110 participants from various renowned institutions joined and explored the World's popular low-code application framework from Oracle.





























The University entered in to an agreement with PPS International in February 2023. Under this agreement, Industry based projects, Internships, placements, Industrial visits for students, Externships for Faculty members and Skill Development Programme for PPS International Employees is provided.

The NorthCap University joined hands with an NGO, Prachyesta – Ek Prayaas through formal MoU on 3rd April 2023 that aims to bring the students and the society together to make life better for the neglected, the adversely affected and the underprivileged regardless of caste, colour, religion or status. View360 Degree Pvt. Ltd.: The NorthCap University signed an MoU with View360 Degree Pvt. Ltd., Gurugram in April 2022


XR Central Pvt. Ltd. : The NorthCap University signed an MPU with XR Central Pvt. Ltd., Gurugram in May 2022

The collaboration encompasses health services, diagnostic services, special checkup camps, expert talks, and sensitization sessions, reinforcing our commitment to the holistic development of our university community.

These MOUs have played a crucial role in strengthening the health and wellness framework at The NorthCap University. Through these collaborations, we have facilitated health awareness, expert guidance, and diagnostic facilities for our students, faculty, and administrative staff.



Mitsubishi Electric India (MEI) Pvt. Ltd.: The University entered in to agreement with MEI in Sept. 2015 which has been subsequently renewed till March 2026. Under this agreement, MEI provided equipment and related software worth Rs. 32,38,800 for students and Faculty to do projects on these. Mitsubishi also provides training in their Gurgaon office/in NCU Campus to Faculty, Staff and students on the equipment provided by them. MDE Department, NCU had developed a Centre of Excellence of Mitsubishi Lab in 2022 to facilitate all those who want to get benefits from the equipment provided by the MEI.

Academic Collaborations and Immersion with International Universities

In our relentless pursuit of excellence and global engagement, NCU has fostered academic collaborations with 31 distinguished universities across various continents. These partnerships have brought forth a multitude of opportunities to enhance the quality of education and enrich the experiences of our students and faculty members. Our academic partnerships have enabled collaborative research, co-teaching by international faculty, curriculum enhancements to meet global standards and opportunities for student-faculty exchange programs. Joint conferences and cultural immersion programs have allowed cross-cultural interactions, promoting a deeper understanding of the world's diversity. In addition, NCU offers students the choice of pursuing pathway programs at partner universities, as well as the option to spend a semester abroad. NCU's dedication to internationalization aligns with our mission of preparing students to excel in a globalized world and contribute significantly to society.

Immersion Programmes

Arizona State University, USA: NCU student participated in the "Sustainability and Innovation" Summer Immersion Program at Arizona State University from 18th June to 1st July 2023. NCU awarded this student a \$1000 scholarship to support this participation in the program. The program offered the student an immersive experience on ASU's campus, focusing on sustainability, innovation, and entrepreneurship through interactive activities, inspiring discussions, and innovative teaching methods. This program was accessible to both undergraduate and postgraduate students at NCU.



Shibaura Institute of Technology, Japan: Accompanied by a faculty member, a group of twelve students embarked on a one-week summer immersion program at Shibaura Institute of Technology in Tokyo, Japan, held from 31st July to 5th August 2023. During this experience, the students had the opportunity to immerse themselves in Japanese culture and visit the SIT Japan

laboratories. As part of their cultural exploration, the students had the chance to wear "Yukata' and interact with Japanese students. In addition to these cultural activities, they enjoyed a tour of Tokyo, the capital city of Japan.



Esa Unggul University, Indonesia: A group of five students, accompanied by a faculty member, participated in a one-week summer immersion program at Universitas Esa Unggul in Indonesia from 23rd to 29th July 2023. During their visit, the students delved into the rich cultural diversity of Indonesia. They engaged in Indonesian language classes designed for foreign speakers (BIPA classes) conducted by the faculty, enabling them to use Bahasa Indonesia in their daily interactions. The students also had the opportunity to interact with local people and fellow students at Universitas Esa Unggul.

As part of their cultural exploration, the students had the chance to create 'Batik,' a renowned Indonesian art form. They also practised playing the 'Angklung,' an indigenous musical instrument featuring bamboo tubes suspended in a bamboo frame and bound with rattan cords. In addition to these cultural activities, they enjoyed a tour of Jakarta, the capital city of Indonesia.



Student's Mobility with foreign Universities

In partnership with ASU, The NorthCap University is pleased to announce accelerated Master's programs, which include an MS in Organizational Leadership for MBA students, an MS in Software Engineering for B.Tech. CSE students, and an MS in Computer Science for B.Tech. ECE students. Through this collaboration, students have the opportunity to earn specific credits at NCU that can be transferred to ASU, resulting in a reduction in their total fees, program duration, and living expenses while studying at ASU in the United States to complete their Master's degrees. After earning a Master's degree at ASU, an OPT option of three years is offered.

Furthermore, in conjunction with Shibaura Institute of Technology in Tokyo, Japan, six students have been nominated for a semester exchange program in Spring 2024. The International Relations Office received an overwhelmingly positive response for the semester exchange opportunity at SIT Japan.

Additionally, as part of our collaboration with the University of North Florida, two student have been nominated for a semester abroad Spring 2024.




Collaborative research

ESTABLISHMENT OF NCU SCHOOL OF BUSINESS ____

The NorthCap University has carved out the NCU School of Business to provide high-quality education in Business Studies.

Vision of this School being:

- · To create a high-quality Business School to be able to compete with the top schools in India and abroad
- · To build a high-quality education ecosystem to develop future generation of leaders
- · To develop meaningful partnerships with industry and academia

For creating innovative and pioneering curriculum and learning, NCU has curated an Advisory Board comprising of leaders from Indian industry, and distinguished academicians from India and abroad. We have also brought on board Professors of Practice with significant industry experience that would help the school in infusing real-life exposure to students. The NCU School of Business proposes to offer two programs - MBA and MBA in Business Analytics. Both are two-year full time management programs spanning 4 semesters with a mandatory Summer Internship for a minimum of 2 months sandwiched between the two years of study.

MBA

This two-year full time management program is meticulously designed to develop well rounded management professionals with "Pi" shaped skillsets. The curriculum design of the first year is geared towards providing a broad understanding of the overall area of management by means of a set of core courses covering all the major management disciplines, some allied areas and some new- age courses. At the end of the first year, during the summer, all students go through a mandatory Summer Internship for a minimum of two months. The foundational classroom sessions during the first year and the industry exposure during the Summer Internship period together provide the necessary grounding to elevate our students into absorbing depth through specialization courses that are offered as electives during the second year of study. Students could specialize in any area of their choice -- Finance, HR, Marketing, Operations, Business Analytics based on their individual interests. Apart from the regular curriculum a set of hands-on workshops, industry speaker sessions, industry visits, conclaves etc. are also organized to make our students either industry-ready or, embark on their own entrepreneurial journey.

MBA in Business Analytics

This two-year full time management program is specifically designed to develop Business Analytics professionals who can take on the ever-morphing analytics landscape in the domain of business. Similar to the MBA program, the first year of study would equip all students with a broad knowledge of the major management disciplines and allied areas. Additionally, MBA in Business Analytics students shall go through some quant-intensive courses during the first year to bolster the mathematics-statistics-programming base that is very essential to build-on with analytics specialization courses during the second year of study. Summer Internship for a minimum of two months is mandatory between the first and second year. The second-year electives cover the latest tools and techniques prevalent in the analytics industry and are offered by experts through a judicious mix of theoretical concepts and hands-on sessions. Besides participating in the skill-development workshops, industry speaker sessions, industry visits, and conclaves, Business analytics students must complete a Capstone project in Analytics during the final semester which would increase their chances of landing lucrative analytics jobs after graduation.

We have initiated activities for both future Admissions planning and current Placements planning. The School of Business proposes to seek AICTE approval for its programs. We are also engaging with international institutions to not only enrich the classroom experience but also bring on board meaningful exchange programs and dual programs.

INDUCTION PROGRAMME 2023 BY NCU SCHOOLS & DEPARTMENTS ____

The Orientation Programme for the incoming batch of 2023 unfolded on 10th and 11th August marking the commencement of a meticulously curated three-week induction program. 


Book Exhibition of Hindi Books on Hindi Diwas

Panel Discussion on 'Regulatory Issues In Green Hydrogen Policy & Its Future In India'

In the wake of the climate crisis, there is an emergent need to lower carbon emissions while meeting the continually increasing demand for energy supply. The budget session, 2023 has approved a budget of Rs 19,744 crore for the National Green Hydrogen Mission. This mission has a focal point to make India a global "hydrogen hub" and a leader in terms of commercial production of hydrogen. The objective of the green hydrogen mission is to cater towards green hydrogen production capacity of about 125 GW in India by 2030. But production of green hydrogen is a capital-intensive process and has impediments like risk of undesirable sunk cost, technology cost, absence of dedicated government policy, and lack of public awareness. In light of the same, the panel discussion aimed to objectively wield much needed academic discourse on the regulatory issue in Green Hydrogen Policy and its future in India. The esteemed panellists for the event included Mr. Shashikant Yadav, Doctoral Researcher, University of Surrey, United Kingdom, and Associate, Surrey Centre for International and Environment Law; Prof. (Dr.) Bharti, Professor, National Law University, Delhi and Dr. Swati Jindal, Advocate-on-Record, Supreme Court of India and Empanelled advocate, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change. Unfortunately, the numbers of acid attack cases are still on the rise despite amended laws which indicates that merely criminalizing acid attack is not enough, instead a deeper deliberation is needed on core issues surrounding the crime of acid attack such as the acid sales restrictions, prosecution, and rehabilitation realities post 2013. Further, to uproot this crime from its base there is a need to understand acid attack in the social context by examining the underlying causes, its consequences and further to overcome the multiple barriers to justice for its victims.

In this background, the workshop was conceptualized with the basic objectives of taking stock of the progress made by India in the sphere of law and create a space for discussion on all matters pertaining to legal issues concerning acid attack. Further, the purpose was to sensitize law students about this menace and take initiatives towards rehabilitation and providing legal aid. The esteemed resource persons were Hon'ble Ms. Santosh Snehi Mann, Member Secretary, National Legal Services Authority (NALSA), Dr. Navpreet Kaur, Co-founder and Vice President of Laxmi Foundation and Mr. Prince, acid attack survivor. The workshop deliberated upon various schemes of NALSA for acid attack rehabilitations and the actions taken by the Indian Government as well as State Governments by providing restorative justices to survivors through compensation schemes. Further, deliberation was made upon the prevalence of acid attacks in India, motives behind the attacks, consequences on victims, and shortcomings in measures adopted to prevent the crime and provide justice to victims. Besides, the survivor shared his experience and sensitized the students in providing legal aid.

LIBRARY & INFORMATION RESOURCE CENTRE

Library & Information Resource Centre

The Library and Information Resource Centre (LIRC) at The NorthCap University, a vanguard of its ever-growing infrastructure development, consistently receives principal attention from its management. It has a rich collection of books, journals, and online resources. Currently, the LIRC has a collection of over 1,00,000 volumes (including Book Bank) in all areas of Engineering, Law, Sciences, and Management. The LIRC subscribes to over 50 print Scopus and UGC care listed and BCI-recommended journals. LIRC updated its computerized services from KOHA library Software during the reporting year. A bar-coded system is placed on each book to enable circulation, and an RFID system is planned.

Facilities provided by LIRC

Online Renewal of Books: LIRC provides the facility of online renewal of books to all its users. A borrower can reissue Library books issued to their account from anywhere through the WEB OPAC facility. The link to use this facility on the library page is https://opac.ncuindia.edu/

Reservation of Books: This facility allows users to reserve books issued out and thus not available in the library.

Back Volumes of Print Journals: LIRC has enriched its collection by compiling volumes of print journals coming to the library. These volumes are available for reading and issue.



Digital Library (Multimedia Section): This section allows users to access the electronic resources subscribed by LIRC. Twenty dual-core machines with printer and scanner facilities have been installed for users. Headphones for access to audio-video materials are provided.

Special Collections: The LIRC has a special collection of thesis gifted by Professor Prem Vrat, Pro-Chancellor of The NorthCap University. These theses are available for reading in the library. The LIRC has also procured a complete set of 'McGraw Hill Encyclopedia of Science and Technology and many other important reference books for users.

DELNET (Developing Library Network): In this information age, no library is completely sufficient to provide all the services to users on its own. DELNET is a national network of libraries established with a mission to support member libraries and promote the culture of resource sharing. NCU LIRC is also a member of Delnet. Any user can request access to books and journal articles not available in the Library through Delnet.

Tata Mc Graw Hill- E-Books: LIRC subscribes to the TMH e-books on engineering, management, applied sciences, computer science, etc. This database has many advanced features like downloading books, creating bookshelves within the database, etc.

Online Resources: LIRC subscribes to online electronic resources such as the EBSCO Host, Westlaw, MANUPATRA, SCC Online, Springer Nature, DELNET, etc.

Notification on Every Transaction: Library offers its students a user alert service. Users get a notification through email/SMS on every transaction.

Job placements are arranged by inviting companies for an on-campus selection process and nominating students to prospective employers for their in-house selection process. The focus is on widening industry reach and getting better salary packages for our students. Approximately 192+companies are recruiting from the University.

CPAA's relentless efforts resulted in over 78% placements of eligible students from all three Schools — School of Engineering & Technology, School of Management, and School of Law, Class of 2023. 
