In-house speakers Dr. Vandana Khanna, Mr. Ishwar Singh and Dr. Anil Jharotia gave a comprehensive overview of all types of e-resources, including how to access from a single Koha OPAC interface, VPN access facility, DELNET subscription, among others. Community Service Events

- On 28th May, a funding of ₹1,00,000 was granted to UBA NCU by The Unnat Bharat Abhiyan National Coordinating Institute, IIT Delhi, under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan for the project titled 'Integrated and Optimised Fermentation Equipment for Community Cow Dung Manure', to be executed in the NCU UBA Network village Sardana. The completion of the project is expected to take 6 months. The investigators for the same are Dr. Vaishali Sahu and Ms. Akanksha Kaushik. This project aims to enhance the solid waste management in the village and shall involve collaboration with local farmers and stakeholders to ensure effective implementation and long-term benefits.
- On 1st May, Club Manovriti organised an awareness session on the benefits and importance of organ donation in collaboration with Mohan Foundation and CII-YI, a registered NGO that encourages people to be certified organ donors by spreading awareness about who are eligible for organ donation. 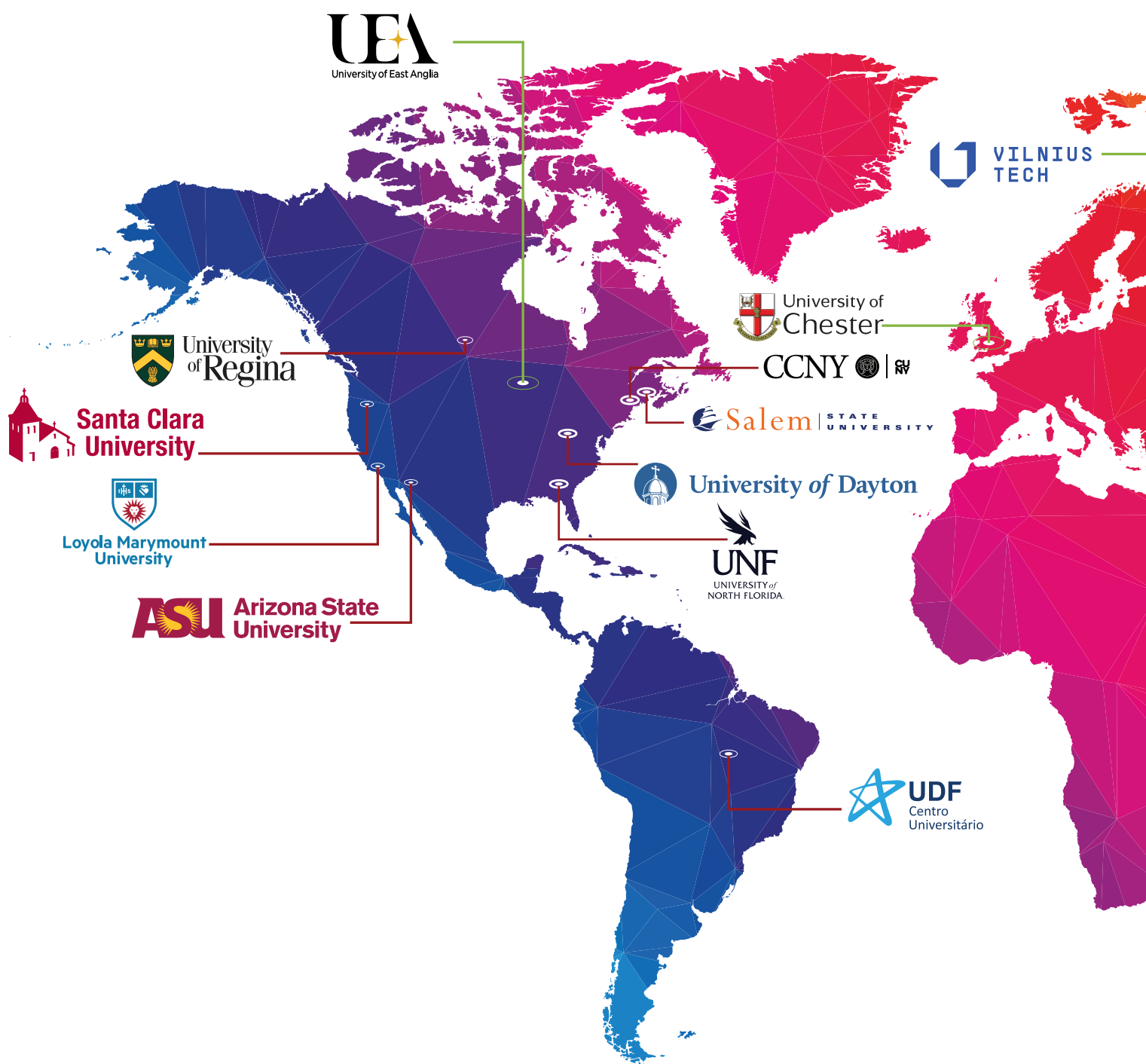
